PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

Mix a solution consisting of 3/4 cup of tap water and 1/4 cup bleach (Clorox, etc.) in a container suitable for immersing the seed cutting knife. Always sterilize the knife whenever making cuts into a fresh seed piece. Cut each seed potato into pieces. Each seed piece should have at least 2 eyes and weigh approximately 2 oz. Spread the seed pieces out in a cool dry location until all potato surfaces are dry. Plant each seed piece 3" deep, leaving 12" between seed pieces.

Each row should be 36" apart. When plants reach 8" hill up dirt to cover all but 2" of plant. After foliage growth has yellowed, withered and died down, the potatoes may be dug.
